

Cart/ATV/Cycles Policy

This policy covers all non-car/truck vehicles including gas, electric or diesel powered carts, wheeler, ATVs, cycles, or any other non-car/truck vehicles that may be used on the rodeo grounds during rodeo weekend.

If your off-road transportation is not hauling trash, officially moving the handicap or directly used in security it will need to be registered to be on the grounds. If it does not have an official business reason or is not registered please leave it at home.

Registration will work like this:

1. Complete the registration information below (see Ron Vermillion)
2. Return the completed details to Ron Vermillion
3. Your request will be reviewed and may be deigned (by Security)
4. If approved it will only be used by the person or persons identified (no one else)
5. Do not expect to be able to give others permission to drive or operate
6. You may be required to only operate within a specific area and at specific times
7. Vehicles found or stopped and not being used as agreed will be asked to be removed.
8. Security will have a list of the approved vehicles and will be asked to make checks
9. Vehicles left or parked in non-designated areas will be asked to be removed and possibly from the grounds
10. People operating vehicles that are not registered may also be asked to leave the vehicle where it is.

This has become a serious issue with a number of different parties, groups and organizations. We frankly do not have the space or the ability to police the numbers of these vehicles that have been present in recent years.
