NOTICE OF SCHOLARSHIP

The Elizabeth Stampede Foundation will award SCHOLARSHIPS for charitable purposes and/or to assist families in our community who are in need.

1. Eligibility

- completion of a scholarship application form
- one letter of recommendation from an unrelated party

2. Criteria

- service to community
- financial need
- emergency situation
- educational uses

3. Requirements

- completion of Scholarship Application form
- one letter of recommendation
- a written statement, maximum of 500 words, in which you:
 - 1. Address the needs to which the scholarship funds will be used
 - 2. Explain how the community, institution or individual will benefit from the scholarship

4. Deadline for Applications: June 30

5. Mail application to Elizabeth Stampede Foundation, PO Box 1062, Elizabeth, CO 80107

Scholarships are awarded without regard to race, creed, ethnic background, religion or gender. The Foundation will consider scholarship requests to assist educational institutions, to assist in the undertaking or completion of civic projects which benefit our community or surrounding communities, and to assist persons in need due to tragedy or financial difficulty. The approval of scholarships will be decided by the Board of Directors and will be based on the purpose for which the scholarship is requested and how closely the purpose meets the mission and goals of the Foundation.

Scholarship recipients must use the funds for the purpose stated in the Scholarship Application and will berequired to make quarterly reports to the Foundation regarding how the funds are being used, as well

as an accounting of the fund. At the conclusion of the project or the final use of funds, the recipient must make a final report to the board. The Board of Directors will have the absolute authority to require audits or further information from the recipient regarding the use of funds.
